Specifications for Trash Containers and Trash Removal at the O.H. Ivie and E.V. Spence Reservoirs: Contract will begin January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2023.

1. The contractor will provide the trash containers of the correct size and number to the recreational areas listed below:

Location of the containers in each area will be determined by the Lake Superintendent

2. Containers will be water tight to prevent leakage of liquids around the container site. The contractor will be responsible for maintaining all containers in a sanitary condition and in good repair. CRMWD may require repair or replacement of containers that do not meet the above criteria.

3. All trash collection by the contractor will occur between 12:00 p.m. on Mondays and 5:00 p.m. on Tuesdays. An extra 24 hours will be allowed on weeks preceding a holiday weekend with a Monday holiday. Trash collection must occur once a week, at a minimum.
4. The contractor will be responsible for any and all damages or injury that might occur as a result of his operation to any CRMWD property, facility, park user or park property.
5. Any litter that is a result of the dumping of trash containers will be picked up by the contractor.
6. Additional containers will be provided by the contractor upon request by CRMWD at an established rate per container size and dump cycle if needed.
7. It is the responsibility of the contractor to dispose of all trash in a state approved sanitary landfill.
8. All trash will be transported by a commercial truck designed for the purpose of loading and hauling trash.
9. Successful bidder is required to furnish original Certificates of Insurance with the following limits:
 - a. General Liability with a minimum of \$500,000
 - b. Workers Compensation with statutory limits
 - c. Automobile Liability (include hired and non-owned autos) with a minimum of \$500,000 Combined Single Unit
 - d. Submit waiver of subrogation endorsement for General Liability and Auto Liability
10. The Colorado River Municipal Water District reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to accept any bid deemed advantageous to CRMWD. Any deviation from these specifications must be stated in detail with complete reference to the bid specification provision from which the deviation is being made.
11. CRMWD is not required to accept the lowest bid. In addition to cost, service will also serve as a basis for award of the contract.
